

- X. The trust may receive donations for specific projects or activities, for which Directions may be given by the donor, and carry out the activities as per the wishes of the donor.
- XI. The objects and the beneficiaries of the trust and trust funds shall not be restricted to caste, creed, community or religion or sect and shall be open and made available to all.
- XII. The objects of the trust shall not be carried on with profit motive.
- XIII. The income and the funds of the trust shall be applied or notified towards charitable purposes only in India or shall be accumulated for carryout the objects of the trust only within India.
- XIV. The trust is irrevocable and the author of the trust does not reserve any right to revoke the TRUST and does not reserve any benefit directly or indirectly for himself or any of his relatives.
- XV. The funds and income of the trust shall be solely utilised towards the objects of the trust and no portion of the same shall be utilised for payment to the trustees by way of profit, interest, dividend, etc.,
- XVI. The trustees shall, at all times, stand indemnified in respect of any act that may have been done bonafide by them in respect of matters relating to the Trust.
- XVII. The trustees shall have power to frame rules and regulations not inconsistent with the terms and conditions of the instrument in order to carry out the purposes and objects of the trust and to suitably alter and amend such rules and regulations whenever they think fit to do so in the interests of the trust.
- XVIII. The trustees may add to supplement, modify, alter amend the objects of the trust, provided, however they shall be charitable in nature and the same shall be carried out only with the previous approval of the Commissioner of Income Tax.
